

Sheridan Fire District Meeting Minutes

November 5th, 2020

The Sheridan Fire District Trustees met on Thursday November 5th, 2020 with the following present. Robert Varnes, Paul Brennan, Chief Tirevold and Attorney Rich Burton. Meeting called to order by President Varnes at 7 pm. Brennan was made Secretary Pro Temp in the absence of Debra Augsburg. Octobers minutes were read and approved with no additions or corrections. Bills for the month were discussed, Chief explained the bills. Brennan motioned to pay the bills, Varnes 2nd the motion. Treasurers report discussed. Chief stated we received Foreign Fire Tax Check this month. The running on call pay out for Fire is \$840.00 and the EMS is \$9600.00, this will be paid on with the November payroll. Chief discussed transferring \$25,000 from the Ambulance Fund to the Ambulance Reserve Fund. The District will have made all transfers for FY 20-21. Brennan motioned to pass Resolution 11052020 Transfer of \$25,000 from ambulance fund to ambulance reserve fund. Varnes 2nd the motion. Brennan motioned to accept the Treasures report, Varnes 2nd the motion. Chief stated the department responded to a record 15 fire calls for the month and also 40 ambulance calls. New daily record of 9 calls in 8 hours on October 17th, 5 fire and 4 ambulance calls. Safety report—COVID activity picking up, farmers out and about with machinery. Brush Truck 831 in for pump motor leaks, all gaskets need to be replaced. Chief stated GEMT will be asking for money back from Public Aid Payments due to overpayment. DNR grant money received. FEMA Grant for new used Rescue Pumper denied. No word on the attic from Phalen. Leary Foundation Grant to 3rd round for new battery operated rescue tools. Handi cap pad replacement to get done this month. IPRF received a Stimulus Grant, Sheridan got a IPRF check for \$339.00 from the grant. District Inventory to be completed by 2/1/2021. Memorial Donation in memory of Alda Michaelson, was \$250 plus a tree.

Attorney Burton stated the Tax levy has been Filed. Being no other business, Brennan motioned to adjourn the meeting at 7:10 pm, Varnes 2nd the motion. Meeting adjourned
