

Sheridan Fire District Meeting Minutes

The Sheridan Fire District Trustees met on Thursday April 7th, 2022 with the following present: Debra Augsborg, Paul Brennan, Jeff Werner, Attorney Mike Fuller and EMS Lt Marla Hardyman. Augsborg called the meeting to order at 7 pm. Minutes of the February meeting were read and approved with no additions or corrections. Brennan motioned to accept the minutes, Werner 2nd the motion. Bills were presented and discussed, Werner motioned to pay the bills, Brennan 2nd the motion. Bills to get paid. Treasures report was given. On call pay for ambulance is at \$2355.00 and the fire is \$130.00. Chief and Attorney Burton working on the B & A 22-23 with the public hearing being scheduled for May 5th Trustee Meeting. CURES Payment of \$145,000 has been received by the Sheridan Fire District. Chief to get copies of budget to board members prior to May meeting. Discussion on where donations go. Donations are placed in the General Fire or Ambulance Fund depending how it is specified. Brennan motioned to accept the Treasures report as presented, Werner 2nd the motion. The department ran 24 ambulance calls and 3 fire calls in March. Still waiting for new ambulance to get in to Foster Coach for repair. Burlington Northern RR Group will hold their Swap meet here at the FD on Saturday May 7th from 6 am to 9 pm. Sheridan EMS participated in an Active Shooter Drill on March 30th at the Serena High School. Landscaping will be done as weather permits and the new floor will be scheduled for July or August of this year. Debra Augsborg has agreed to renew her Trustee position on the board. Chief will have new list of annual appointments at the May meeting. Serena Fire Department was sold 6 older portable radios we don't use anymore at a cost of \$200 per radio. Flowers were ordered for Paul Marshall, Serena Fire District Trustee, who has passed away. Chief will be reviewing Policies and Procedures and getting signatures for update. Annual Flow Tests were done on the SCBA Units here at Sheridan. Newark will be hosting a LP Burn at Newark on 4/21/2022. Discussion held on the current On Call pay for responding to calls. Currently the EMT Basics get \$10.00 per call and the Medics \$25.00. Chief requested that be increased to \$15/\$30. Brennan motioned to increase the per call pay, Werner 2nd the motion.
