

Sheridan Fire District Meeting Minutes

07/07/2022

The Sheridan Fire District Trustees met on Thursday July 7th, 2022 with the following present: Paul Brennan, Jeff Werner, Chief Tirevold and Attorney Mike Fuller. Meeting called to order at 7 pm by Werner. Werner was made President Pro Temp in absence of Augsburg. Minutes of the June meeting were read and approved. Brennan motioned to accept the minutes as read, Werner 2nd the motion. Bills for the month were discussed. Brennan motioned to pay the bills, Werner 2nd the motion. Bills to get paid. Treasurers report presented. Chief stated the District received the 1st installment of property taxes for the year. Ambulance On call pay is at \$7035, Fire is at \$330. Stan Foreman donated \$500 to the Ambulance Fund. Discussion held on Fund Transfers. Brennan motioned to transfer \$20,000 from Ambulance Fund to Ambulance Reserve Fund and \$20,000 from General Fire Fund to Fire Reserve Fund. Werner 2nd the motioned. Werner motioned to accept the Treasurers report, Brennan 2nd the motion. Chief state the department responded to 44 ambulance and 9 fire calls in June. Safety Report on Dry conditions and heat emergencies. Foster Coach to be notified of paint chips on the new ambulance. No word on FEMA grant. Chief to contact Reggie on apparatus floor status. Chief reported on open house on July 3rd, went well, with about 150-200 people that went through. All trucks in the parade. New Microwave, pressure washer purchased for the station. Old bunker gear and foam donated to Amboy Fire to be shipped to Ukraine. Werner motioned to purchase 50 gallons of foam, Brennan 2nd the motion. Discussion held on the Gas meter in the truck bay. Chief to contact FICEK and order new one at a cost about about \$2100. Chief stated we had one smoke detector get replaced. Chief in contact with Thompson Electric to get all detectors replaced due to age factor. Chief to get with billing company to work on Cost report for GEMT for 2023. Chief got permission to obtain price from H & H builders on getting some basic drawings done for new addition for sleeping quarters and truck bays. No other business, Werner motioned to adjourn the meeting at 710 pm, Brennan 2nd the motion.
