Chiefs Report

Chief to start on new engine loan paperwork from the OSFM in March. After talking with Mark Nixon, the new engine will be pushed back to April 2026 for delivery. Payment can be in May 2026. Chief to get quote on new truck being delivered to the Sheridan Fire Department instead of staff going to Louisiana to pick it up. Chief to have it by the March meeting if not before. Chief has purchased most of the big-ticket items for the new engine currently. Chief may hold off on purchasing smaller items until truck arrives. Attorney Burton has received word the Formation of the Fire District paperwork has been found and filed with the County Clerks office. Chief purchased smoke detectors for the station. QuickBooks invoice for about \$2500.00 will be due in April for Payroll, QuickBooks etc. Chief discussed the possibility of replacing the furnace. Quote from Grassers is approximately \$3,900.00. Moisture is getting into the furnace. Possibly a cracked heat exchanger. Wormley motioned to purchase new furnace when needed, Brennan 2nd the motion. Chief to purchase when needed.
