### **Approval of Minutes**

## **Chiefs Report**

1 Mary 13 will need to have new siren installed; we purchased the siren but will go to Foster Coach to install it. 1 Mary 14 had light/wiring issues, Chief Tirevold fixed all that. Chief has been in contact with OSFM for the Revolving Truck Loan. Once we get a firm date on new truck delivery, paperwork will be started. Chief discussed picking the new engine up or having it delivered, and all agreed to have it delivered to FD when completed. Cost of the new ambulance will be in the \$455,000 to \$460,000 range due for delivery in July. Chief discussed getting rid of shower curtains and installing shower doors after May 1<sup>st</sup>. Chief has donated a Craftsman toolbox and a lot of hand tools for the new engine. Chief Tirevold finished purchasing hand tools, shovels and brooms. Chief will be ordering foam and the deck gun nozzle. If department does not get the hose and rescue tool on the Small Equipment grant, the district will have to purchase those items. We should be well set except for getting the radio installed for the new engine.

Chief stated he will be looking for a company to legally back up district files due to the lack of storage space we are running into.

Discussion held on annual insurance. Chief will start next year to get bids on insurance for the district.
